



PALM OIL PRICE REPORT ON 17th WEEK (22nd – 26th APR 2024)

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE LOCAL & EXPORT MARKET TRADED EASIER

Crude Palm Oil (CPO) prices were traded **easier** this week, **lower by RM150.50 to RM4,052.50/tonne** as against **RM4,203.00/tonne** in the previous week. The highest and lowest traded CPO prices were at RM4,180.00/tonne (23rd Apr) and RM3,900.00/tonne (25th Apr) respectively. Meanwhile, **RBD Palm Olein (FOB) prices** were traded **lower** at **US\$892.50/tonne** this week as compared to **US\$926.50/tonne** in the previous week. The **lower** CPO prices were mainly due to:

- Weaker soyabean oil prices on the Chicago Board of Trade (CBOT) and China's Dalian Commodity Exchange. Palm oil prices are affected by the movement of soyabean oil prices as they compete for a share in the global vegetable oils market.
- Weaker Brent crude oil prices in the world market makes palm oil less attractive option for biodiesel.
- Expectations of higher CPO production due to seasonal trend.

PALM OIL PRICES IN THE EUROPE MARKET TRADED EASIER

- **CPO** price was traded **easier**, **lower by US\$20.50 to US\$1,013.50/tonne**, with premium vis-à-vis SBO price narrowed at US\$65.00/tonne this week.
- **RBD Palm Olein** price was traded **weaker**, **lower by US\$32.50 to US\$995.50/tonne**, with premium of US\$47.00/tonne as against SBO price.
